OVERVIEW:

Candidates in this position are responsible for building high-performing and reliable track loaders and skid steer loaders as part of a team committed to working safely. The successful candidate demonstrates reliability, punctuality and can work effectively as part of a team.

RESPONSIBILITIES:

- Follows work instructions to produce quality product in a safe and timely manner.
- Uses various manual and pneumatic tools to fit components together.
- Inspects work for quality.
- Installs moving parts, such as shafts, levers, or bearings, and works them to test free movement.
- Installs pipe and hose for hydraulic systems.
- Disassembles and reassembles, when necessary to ensure proper, quality assembly of product.
- Tests or assists in testing operation of completed product.
- Responsible for keeping area neat and orderly.
- Keep daily records of serial numbers and other paperwork.

QUALIFICATIONS:

Education and/or Experience:
